**Mayor's Report-** The mayor informed the council that he authorized Paul to have the additional snow blade repaired, noting that it will be beneficial given the amount of snow expected this season.

**Maintenance Report -** Paul discussed with the council on snow removal, cemetery, and the sampler.

Up for discussion was whether the council would consider and approve Heiar's proposal to raise the garage structure and replace the concrete at 442 Ferry Road. The mayor informed the council that the City has submitted this issue as an insurance claim, as the problem arose from the garage being constructed over a storm drain due to the City's oversight.

Mayor Meyer emphasized that if the council chooses to allow payment of Heiar's insurance claim, it should be clearly understood that this would be the only such claim the City will agree to pay. No precedent will be set for future claims of this nature. After brief discussion, L. Horst made a motion to approve the insurance claim for 442 Ferry Road, with the understanding that this will be the only claim of this nature the City will agree to pay. N. Voss seconded the motion. Motion carried. Ayes 5, Nays 0.

The mayor informed the Council that Joe Kilburg had contacted him to provide advance notice that the school intends to hire a marketing professional to promote the City of Miles, the school district, and the City of Preston. At this time, Joe was unable to provide any cost estimates but anticipated having additional information available in January.

Mayor announced the next council meeting will be Tuesday, January 13, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.

**Motion to adjourn –** N. Voss made a motion to adjourn the council meeting, seconded by A. Petersen. Meeting adjourned at 6:14 pm. Motion carried. Ayes 5, Nays 0.

After the meeting, the Clerk administered the Oath of Office to all newly elected officials.
