

ORDINANCE NO. 21-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-2-2(6) IN THE CITY OF MILES, IOWA CODE OF ORDINANCES BY CHANGE THE AUTHORITY AND CLARIFYING EXISTING LANGUAGE

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Miles, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. Section 6-2-2 “Use of the Public Sewers”, number 6, is hereby repealed and a new Section is adopted as follows:

6. Grease, oil, and sand interceptors shall be provided by the owner of the establishment when, in the opinion of the city council, they are necessary for the proper handling of liquid wastes containing grease in excessive amounts, or any flammable wastes, sand, or other harmful ingredients; except that such interceptors shall not be required for private living quarters or dwelling units. All interceptors shall be of a type and capacity approved by the City Council or contracted inspector, and shall be located as to be readily and easily accessible for cleaning and inspection.

SECTION 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. When Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon posting as required by Iowa law.
